1. Minutes of Last Meeting

Minutes of the meeting in June were approved.

2. Chairperson's Report

Neil updated the Parent Council on the following matters:

Mental Health provision:

- Planned MYPAS (Mental Health Wellbeing Counselling Service) restricted to Gala cluster schools only.
- Discussion around parent interest that funding be made available for floating counselling
- Group of Chairs from Borders Schools continuing to pursue clarity on plan for 2024, and progress on a Borders wide solution.

PC Parent Recruitment:

Leaflet distribution to advertise PC agreed for Senior Awards ceremony. Further discussion postponed for next meeting. Discussion around fundraising being a gateway for parents to get involved. Agreement that the purpose of the parent council is to come up with ideas to support school to improve, lead specific projects (i.e. push for dyslexia schools award), promote fundraising at a time when budgets are increasingly stretched

Dyslexia Support in School:

Staff & PC sub-committee pursuing the British Dyslexia School of Excellence Award. Kathy Huffman & Victoria Tait in process of consulting with schools in Cumbria. Need to evidence Standard of Excellence. Ambition to take cluster wide – starting with Primary Schools

Christmas Fair:

Victoria Tait confirmed Date - 16 November. Meeting arranged with Jane Taylor (past organiser)

- 10 confirmed small stall holders currently, choir, music Santa to be decided.
- Agreement on raffle prizes / save the date

Borders Women's Aid:
