***A message to parents and students,***

As part of Curriculum for Excellence all students need to experience each curriculum area within the school. Curriculum Areas are **Humanities**, **Sciences**, **Technologies**, **Expressive Arts**, Modern Languages, English, Maths, Health & Wellbeing and Religious and Moral Education. This is part of the Broad and General Education set down by Education Scotland.

The first 15 periods of the curriculum are based on the following subjects:
