Students in S1 and S2

Faculty	Time Allocation	Frequency	Possible activities
Maths	1 hour	Weekly	Daily revision/weekly tasks to practice what has been taught in class that week
English	1 hour	Weekly	Reading parts of class novel, private reading, preparation for next lesson
Sciences	30 minutes	Fortnightly	Reading to prepare for next lesson, specific exercises to practice what was covered in class
Humanities	30 minutes	Fortnightly	Reading, subject specific questions
Design and Technologies	30 minutes	Fortnightly	Reading, subject specific questions, practice technique
Music	30 minutes	Monthly	Practice technique, instruments, listen to music
Modern Languages	45 minutes	Weekly	Vocabulary, grammar, listening to spoken language (songs, films, YouTube)

Students in S3

30 minutes per subject - possible activities may include:

- Daily revision/weekly tasks to practice what has been taught in class that week
- Reading, subject specific questions
- Reading to prepare for next lesson
